Alchemy



Alchemy is the ultimate expression of transformation; a deliberate process of turning raw elements into something sacred. This collection bridges the gap between wearable jewelry and functional art for the home reminding us that we are always changing, evolving, and stepping into new versions of ourselves.

The physical act of enameling is an alchemical process in its own right. It requires firing ground glass at intense temperatures until it fuses permanently to metal, shifting from raw powder into a luminous, glassy surface. This metamorphosis directly mirrors the conceptual heart of my collection. The smooth gradient transitions of color across each piece represent the subtle, beautiful shifts of human growth.

Every piece is born from a quiet, meditative workflow. The symbols and motifs found throughout the collection are deeply intentional, drawing from moments of sudden inspiration from the world around me.

By extending these symbols from jewelry into everyday home objects, this collection explores the alchemy of turning everyday function into beauty. They serve as tangible reminders of our own constant evolution, designed to bring a touch of the sacred into your daily rituals.

- All of my pieces will be in a dedicated photo album starting on November 20, which can be found under Media or Files in the group.
- The post will contain all of the necessary information, including starting price, closing time, etc. Be sure to note the closing times on your favorite pieces.
- All items can be bought immediately. Those items will have a BIN (Buy it now) price on them.
- Bidding goes up in increments of \$5.00 or more.

An easy way to save your favorites to keep checking on the bidding is to click the post, look for the 3 dots in the top right corner, and click save, save to a collection that you can create. “Cloisonné: of, relating to, or being a style of enamel decoration in which the enamel is applied and fired in raised cells of wires on a metal background” ~ Merriam Webster Dictionary

It all starts with a design.



Fine silver is then fused to the base layer, more clear enamel is fused to that silver.



I cut each wire to fit, tack it on and eventually fuse them to the enamel by firing them in the kiln. The image above shows the wire right before it's fused.

Using a tiny paint brush to fill the cells with color. The grains are typically the size of fine sugar. Once a layer is added, then it's fired. This process is repeated until the cells are filled with the colors to my liking.



And last but not least, the pieces are then turned into jewelry through my metalsmithing process. Each piece gets it's own unique setting turning it into a piece of wearable art.



Wicked Sass Enamel Earrings

1" X 1.25"



A whimsical witchy pair of earrings with a little sass. Just like slipping on a favorite pair of quirky socks or killer shoes can instantly put a kick in your step, wearing these earrings is an instant mood booster.

Waves of Serenity

.5" X 1.25"



Like the mesmerizing waves of the ocean, colors blend from one to the other merging together to create a flow. Simply watching this phenomenon can allow for an exhale and a calming of the spirit.

The Altered Heart

1.25" X 1.5"

Heartbreak taking many forms happens to us all. Sometimes a little space is left where the loss remains ever present, sometimes, it creates cracks that heal. The shards break away, but are collected and placed together (see the back of the pendant). We move on, sometimes it requires a brave face, but the heart holds the pain and heals itself.

Shining Soul Goddess

.75" X 1.75"



Radiating from the very essence of her core, this goddess is a reminder to grow and reach and glow. Let your inner light shine bright. Where light shines darkness is no longer.

Radical Unfolding Reversible Mandala Necklace

1.45" X 1.45"



Mandalas show up in my work rather often. I think it's because they capture my attention and hold it. Looking at the intricate designs can help re-center and re-ground. Once centered and grounded, this mandala also reminds us to unfold and unfurl our wings to expand to the best expression of ourselves.

Both the front and back have the same mandala - one is enameled and one is enhanced with an amethyst. This becomes a reminder that we are all the same yet different and all are beautiful in our individuality.

Calla Lillies

1.25" X 1.5"



Georgia O'Keefe was a master at color, movement, softness and strength. She reflected that in the way she lived and the way she painted. This is my representation of her Calla Lily painting as an enamel pendant.

Hand painted with vitreous enamel (ground glass fused to metal) in layers and layers create the depth of color. I then carried the calla lily story into the setting enveloping the focal in a bed of hand cut and formed sterling silver leaves.

Unfurling

1.25" X 1.5"



Throughout the summer, I watched flowers start as tight little blossoms and then unfurl into their ultimate beauty. As I witnessed this, I realized that the unfurling happens without fearing exposure.

We often live our lives in a pseudo unfurling where we don't allow the full expression of ourselves as we are "protecting" ourselves. But, what the flowers showed me is that we are missing the full glory of the metaphorical sun warming all of our exposed petals. This pendant is the reminder to unfurl to your best self.

Autumn Splendor

1" round



The transition from summer to autumn is one of my favorite times of year. Stepping onto a trail, you can feel the air change. The rich, warm colors and the crunch of leaves underfoot are music to my senses.

This cloisonné pendant is my way of honoring that forest walk close with glowing autumn hues on the front and a swirl of fallen leaves across the back.

The Sacred Wheel Pendant/Brooch

1.5" X 1.5"



Finding a moment of perfect stillness is rare, but the geometry of Art Deco brings a soothing order to the chaos. The Sacred Wheel is a meditative look at symmetry, balancing the quiet purity of the lotus with the structure of Deco design. Hand-fabricated in cloisonné enamel, this circular pendant-brooch serves as a calm, reminder of the steady, beautiful rhythms of life.

Night Guardian

1.25" X 1.25"



Ever since I was little, I always loved the idea of unseen goddesses doing various jobs. One of my favorites was of a goddess who watched over us all while we slept. Her quiet presence emerged as the sun set and remained until the first rays of rose in the morning.

I used 24k gold to represent light in the windows of the homes she guards.

Guilded Petal Keepsake Locket

1" round



Look closely and you'll see an enameled lotus gracing the front of the pendant. Rotate it, and you'll see a flower in full bloom. Lift the catch and rotate the front to reveal a container in which to place a precious keepsake.

Belladonna Bloom

1.5" X 1.5"



Every year, when this flower is in bloom, I am stopped in my tracks. Over time, I learned it was a poisonous plant. That doesn't stop me from getting up close and personal with the blossom to enjoy it's beauty. This pendant is my representation of its beauty using subtle color transitions while waves of wire illuminate the flow of the petals. The background shimmers yet can't compete with the beauty of the flower.

Mystic Ocean

1.15" focal on a 7" cuff



Dreaming of the Mediterranean Ocean. That rich blue, those clear sparkles, that calming sound were all my inspiration for creating this bracelet. Subtle color transitions are reminiscent of the ocean. Like the waves return back into the ocean, the circles of the bangle represent that cycle.

Watchful Eye Trinket Dish

3" round



If you've followed me long enough, you probably know that I love symbols. To me, they evoke a deep remembering and intense focus. This trinket dish is full of symbols starting with the watchful eye, the lotus, the mandala (the entire dish is shaped like a lotus mandala), geometric shapes, and representation of the celestial sky.

It's pretty, it's functional, and it can be a way to reground yourself. A piece of functional art to keep in your home.

The Lily Capsule

2.5"x2"x1.75"



The calla lily is a symbol of rebirth and life's transitions. Blue is rooted in intuition, inner peace, and personal truth. These two powerful symbols grace the top of this fully hand-formed vessel, transforming a piece of functional art into a physical sanctuary ready to guard your small, most treasured keepsakes.

Solar Glow Capsule

1"x1"x1"



I wanted this tiny, hand-formed capsule to feel like a pocket-sized burst of energy. The lid features a detailed mandala that transitions through a radiant solar spectrum capturing a sense of wholeness and warmth. At just an inch square, it's a quiet piece of functional art made to keep one tiny, irreplaceable treasure safe.

My jewelry journey started when I saw my first enamel in a gallery. I immediately knew that's what I wanted to do even though I really didn't know what enameling was. 20+ years later, my work has developed to creating enameled jewelry that is deeply rooted in symbolism. I love adding secret elements inside, on the back, or by making the piece moveable. It makes it even more magical!

Enameling is the process of fusing glass to metal with heat. It takes many layers (often 15-20) per piece to achieve depth and drama. That depth invites a closer look into the piece and into its story. I frequently create cloisonne (creating and filling cells with enamel) and painting with enamel. The piece dictates the technique.
